Ramon Luis Ayala Rodriguez was born in Puerto Rico in 1977. He played baseball when he was young, and he played a lot of baseball games with his friends. He wanted to be a professional baseball player. But he had a problem with his leg, so he didn't play very well. He knew he wasn't a great athlete, but he liked music, too, and that's where he put his energy. As a teenager, he learned a lot about rap music from rap musicians in his country, Puerto Rico. Ramon worked with other Puerto Rican musicians to create a new kind of music- reggaeton. They all saw Ramon's talent.

In 1995, he made his first album, *No Mercy*, using the name Daddy Yankee. People liked his music, and he made two more albums. But it was Daddy Yankee's fourth album, *El Cangry.com* in 2002 that made him and reggaeton music famous internationally.
