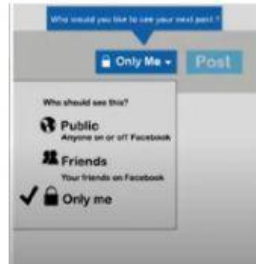
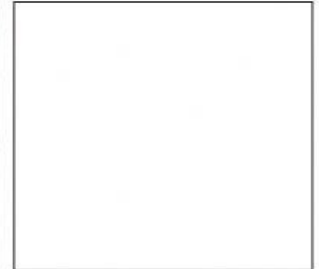
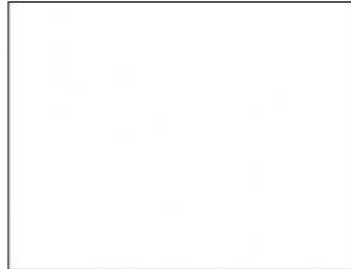


ONLINE SAFETY - 8 TOP TIPS
