### PASSIVE VOICE-2

<i>Present Simple</i>	am/is/are + V3	The work is done.
<i>Past Simple</i>	was/were + V3	The work was done.
<i>Future Simple</i>	will be/shall be +V3	The work will be done.
<i>Present Continuous</i>	is/are being + V3	The work is being done.
<i>Past Continuous</i>	was/were being+V3	The work was being done.
<i>Present Perfect</i>	have been + V3	The work has been done.
<i>Past Perfect</i>	had + V3	The work had been done.
<i>Future Perfect</i>	will have been +V3	The work will have been done.

Two objects in an active sentences mean two possible passive sentences.

The professor gave the students the books.

There are two objects in each of the following sentences:

Object 1 = indirect object → the students

Object 2 = direct object → the books

Passive sentence 1: The students were given the books (by the professor).

Passive sentence 2: The books were given to the students (by the professor).
