<i>Present Simple</i>	am/is/are + V3	The work is done.
<i>Past Simple</i>	was/were + V3	The work was done.
<i>Future Simple</i>	will be/shall be + V3	The work will be done.
<i>Present Continuous</i>	is/are being + V3	The work is being done.
<i>Past Continuous</i>	was/were being + V3	The work was being done.
<i>Present Perfect</i>	have been + V3	The work has been done.
<i>Past Perfect</i>	had + V3	The work had been done.
<i>Future Perfect</i>	will have been + V3	The work will have been done.

There are two objects in each of the following sentences:

Object 1 = indirect object → the students

Object 2 = direct object → the books

Passive sentence 1: **The students** were given the books (by the professor).

Passive sentence 2: **The books** were given **to** the students (by the professor).
