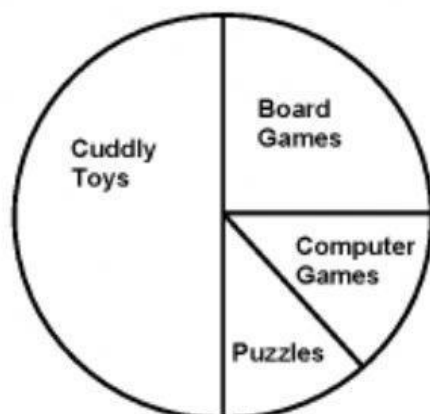


1. A toy shop divides its toys into four groups: *cuddly toys*, *board games*, *computer games* and *puzzles*. The pie chart shows the percentage of each sold in one day.



Type of toy	Percentage sold
Cuddly toys	50%
Board games	25%
Computer games	14%
Puzzles	11%

- If 200 toys were sold altogether, how many were cuddly toys?
- If 200 toys were sold altogether, how many were board games?
- If one of the toys sold on that day were picked at random, what is the probability it would be a board game?

2. Folk singers at a festival came from *England*, *Wales*, *Northern Ireland* and *Scotland*. The pie chart shows the percentage that came from each area.



Area	Percentage
England	31%
Wales	22%
Northern Ireland	28%
Scotland	19%

- If 500 singers attended the festival, how many were from Wales?
