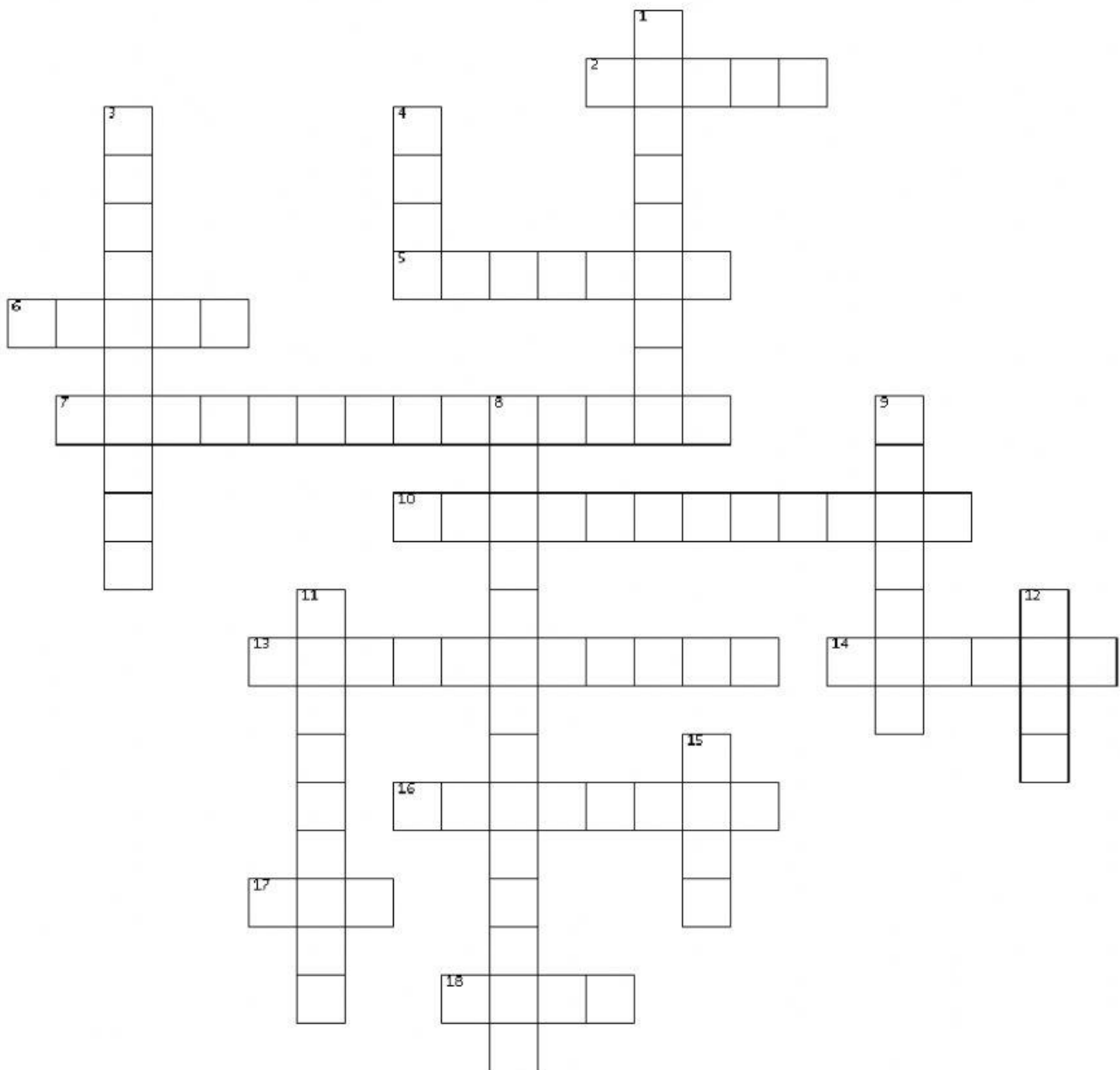

- 7. A CHEMICAL THAT INCREASES CATTLE'S RATE OF GROWTH OR MILK
- 10. THE SYSTEM AT A DAIRY THAT TRANSFERS MILK FROM A COW INTO COOLING AND STORAGE CONTAINERS
- 13. A GROUP OF COWS THAT PRODUCE MILK
- 14. A YOUNG COW THAT HAS NOT BORNE A CALF OR HAS BORNE ONLY ONE CALF
- 16. CATTLE WHICH EAT GRASS FORAGED FROM A PASTURE OR FIELDS
- 17. A FULLY-GROWN FEMALE BOVINE THAT PRODUCES MILK OR BEEF
- 18. A MALE BOVINE ANIMAL THAT IS UNCASTRATED.

- 1. A PLACE WHERE COWS ARE KEPT
- 3. A SPECIAL PROCESS OF HEATING MILK TO KILL BACTERIA
- 4. A YOUNG BOVINE ANIMAL COW OR BULL WHICH IS IN ITS FIRST YEAR
- 8. A SPECIAL AREA WHERE COWS ARE MILKED
- 9. THE PERSON WHO MANAGES A RANCH
- 11. DOMESTICATED ANIMALS WHICH ARE RAISED TO PRODUCE MEAT, EGGS, MILK FUR, LEATHER AND WOOL
- 12. A GROUP OF CATTLE
