- 2. Grammar:** Free of mistakes, adequate use of verb tenses, variety and complexity of different structures. -0.25 per mistake. Serious mistakes will be heavily penalised.
- 3. Vocabulary:** Collocations, false friends, good use of appropriate vocabulary, good spelling, no repetition of elements. -0.25 per mistake. Serious mistakes will be heavily penalised.
- 4. Text:** Organisation of ideas, use of paragraphs, punctuation. Respect for the directions given. There will be penalty in case the writing is too short.
