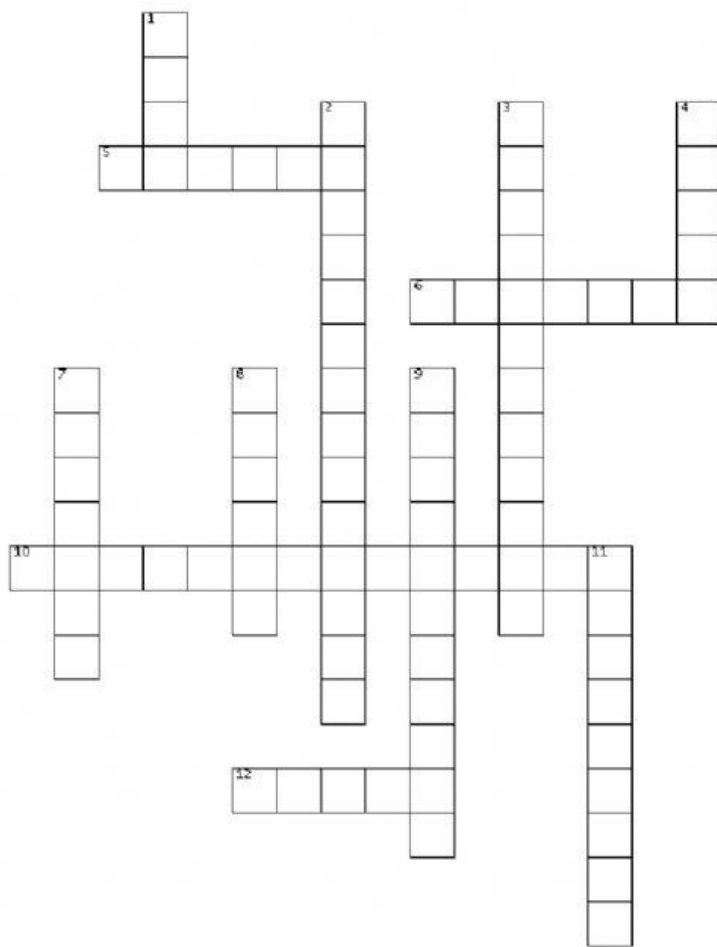


Digestion and Absorption in the Human Body



ACROSS

5. Wastes are stores here before expulsion/egestion.
6. In this muscular pouch, food is mixed with gastric juices.
10. Water and certain vitamins are absorbed here from the undigested food.
12. Fingerlike projections which increase the surface area of the small intestine.

DOWN

1. Produced by the liver, this emulsifies fats to make digestion easier
2. Long convoluted tube where chemical digestion is completed.
3. Acid present in the stomach.
4. Chemical digestion of carbohydrates begins here.
7. Enzyme present in saliva.
8. Enzyme that begins the digestion of proteins.
9. Involuntary muscle contraction, that move the food through the digestive system.
11. Tube between the mouth and the stomach.
