

LOOK OUT!

Drinks are usually uncountable, but they can be countable when we mean 'a cup / glass of ...'.

(uncountable) I don't drink coffee.

(countable) Would you like a coffee? (= a cup of coffee)

We can't do this with food words. We use partitives like 'a bowl of', 'a packet of', etc.

I'd like a bowl of soup.
