



RULES OF SUPERLATIVES

- ℳ Add "**EST**" to short adjectives.
- ℳ Add "**ST**" when they are short adjectives ending in "**e**".
- ℳ Duplicate consonant plus "**EST**" when the adjective ends in consonant-vowel-consonant and must be short, only if it ends in "**w**" this rule does not apply.
- ℳ Change the "**y**" to "**IEST**".
- ℳ Use "**MOST**" when you have adjectives of two or more syllables.
- ℳ Irregular adjectives: good-better, bad-worse, far-farthest.

NOTE: In sentences the adjective is written first and then the subject.



RULES OF COMPARATIVES

- ☞ Add "**ER**".
- ☞ In small adjectives ending in a consonant-vowel-consonant, the last consonant is doubled and "**ER**" is added.
- ☞ If it ends in "**y**" it is replaced by "**i**" and "**ER**" is added.
- ☞ If it has more than two syllables use "**MORE**".
- ☞ Irregular comparisons: good-better, bad-worse, slightly less, far-farther.
