



## RULES OF SUPERLATIVES

- Add "**EST**" to short adjectives.
- Add "**ST**" when they are short adjectives ending in "**e**".
- Duplicate consonant plus "**EST**" when the adjective ends in consonant-vowel-consonant and must be short, only if it ends in "**w**" this rule does not apply.
- Change the "**y**" to "**IEST**".
- Use "**MOST**" when you have adjectives of two or more syllables.
- Irregular adjectives: good-better, bad-worse, far-farthest.

**NOTE:** In sentences the adjective is written first and then the subject.



## RULES OF COMPARATIVES

- Add "ER".
- In small adjectives ending in a consonant-vowel-consonant, the last consonant is doubled and "ER" is added.
- If it ends in "y" it is replaced by "i" and "ER" is added.
- If it has more than two syllables use "MORE".
- Irregular comparisons: good-better, bad-worse, slightly less, far-farther.
