We **had** a nice picnic yesterday.

| AFFIRMATIVE | NEGATIVE         |
|-------------|------------------|
| I had       | I didn't have    |
| You had     | You didn't have  |
| He had      | He didn't have   |
| She had     | She didn't have  |
| It had      | It didn't have   |
| We had      | We didn't have   |
| They had    | They didn't have |
