### PAST SIMPLE – IRREGULAR VERBS

#### REMEMBER

##### *Affirmative (+)*

be – <b>was / were</b>	read – <b>read</b>	write – <b>wrote</b>
have – <b>had</b>	cut – <b>cut</b>	come – <b>came</b>
go – <b>went</b>	eat – <b>ate</b>	swim – <b>swam</b>
do – <b>did</b>	make – <b>made</b>	sing – <b>sang</b>
buy – <b>bought</b>	give – <b>gave</b>	drink – <b>drank</b>
teach – <b>taught</b>	lose – <b>lost</b>	run – <b>ran</b>
win – <b>won</b>	see – <b>saw</b>	take – <b>took</b>

##### *Negative (-)*

I went swimming. I **didn't go** fishing.

He lost the game. He **didn't win** the game.

They ate breakfast late. They **didn't get** up early.

##### *Question (?)*

**Did** you sing the song?

– Yes, I **sang** the song. / No, I **didn't sing** the song.

**Did** he / she / it teach English?

– Yes, he / she / it **taught** English. / No, he / she / it **didn't teach** English

**Did** they buy the cake?

– Yes, they **bought** the cake. / No, they **didn't buy** the cake.
