### Definitions



Sometimes an author will tell the meaning of a word in the same sentence. A word's meaning is its **definition**. A definition can help you understand new words. Look at the sentence after the unknown word to see if the author explains what the word means. Sometimes authors use italics or bold print to identify the meaning of unknown words.

Example: Many pilots want to become *astronauts*, people who have learned to travel in space.

The boy was **unresponsive** when he didn't answer the questions that we asked.
