



The Life Cycle of a Flowering Plant

Draw a line and connect the stages with the correct definition:

Life Cycle Stage	Definition
Pollination	Seeds move away from the parent plant
Fertilisation	When a seed starts to grow into a young plant
Seed Dispersal	A seed is produced when the male and female cells join together
Germination	When a seedling/young plant grows into an adult flowering plant
Growth	When pollen from the anther reaches the stigma
