Remember the affirmative forms:

AFFIRMATIVE

I go to school every day
You go to school every day
He goes to school every day
She goes to school every day
It goes to school every day
We go to school every day
They go to school every day

With **HE**, **SHE** and **IT** we add **S**
or **ES** to the verb.

S or ES?:

- **ES**: for verbs ending in O – CH – SH – SS – ZZ – X
- **IE + S**: for verbs ending in Y after a consonant.
Example:
STUDY = STUDIES

NEGATIVE

I don't go to school every day
You don't go to school every day
He doesn't go to school every day
She doesn't go to school every day
It doesn't go to school every day
We don't go to school every day
They don't go to school every day

Remember the interrogative forms:

INTERROGATIVE
Do I go to school every day? Yes, I do //No, I don't
Do you go to school every day? Yes, I do //No, I don't
Does he go to school every day? Yes, he does //No, he doesn't
Does she go to school every day? Yes, she does //No, she doesn't
Does it go to school every day? Yes, it does //No, it doesn't
Do we go to school every day? Yes, we do //No, we don't
Do they go to school every day? Yes, they do //No, they don't
