- I think email is more faster than letters. (1)
- I think trains are more worse for the environment than airplanes. (1)
- I think taxis are more fast than buses. (1)
- Cars are more bad for the environment than bicycles. (1)
- When I commute in my car the time is more shorter than when taking a taxi. (1)
- She travels to school slower than me. (1)
- Taxis are a lot more quick than buses. (1)
- A camel is more slower than a husky. (1)
- A camel is more useful than a husky because they can upload more things. (1)
- Motorcycles in Colombia are as popular as Greece. (1)
- I think that camels are strongest desert animals. (1)
- Camels are bigger than husky, but husky are faster. (2)
- Husky is faster than camel, but camel is the biggest (4)
- Motorcycle are quicker than bycycles, but bicycles are safest for security. (3)
- Trains are good than buses, but buses are chepest. (3)
- Travel by planes is more expensive than cars, but planes are fastest transportation. (4)
- Ships are worst than planes and ships are slowest. (2)
- Cars are popular than taxis, but buses are the cheapest. (1)
- I think a team huskies is more beautiful than a team camel. (4 – it's the same mistake twice)
- I think a camels are less popular than a husky. (1)
