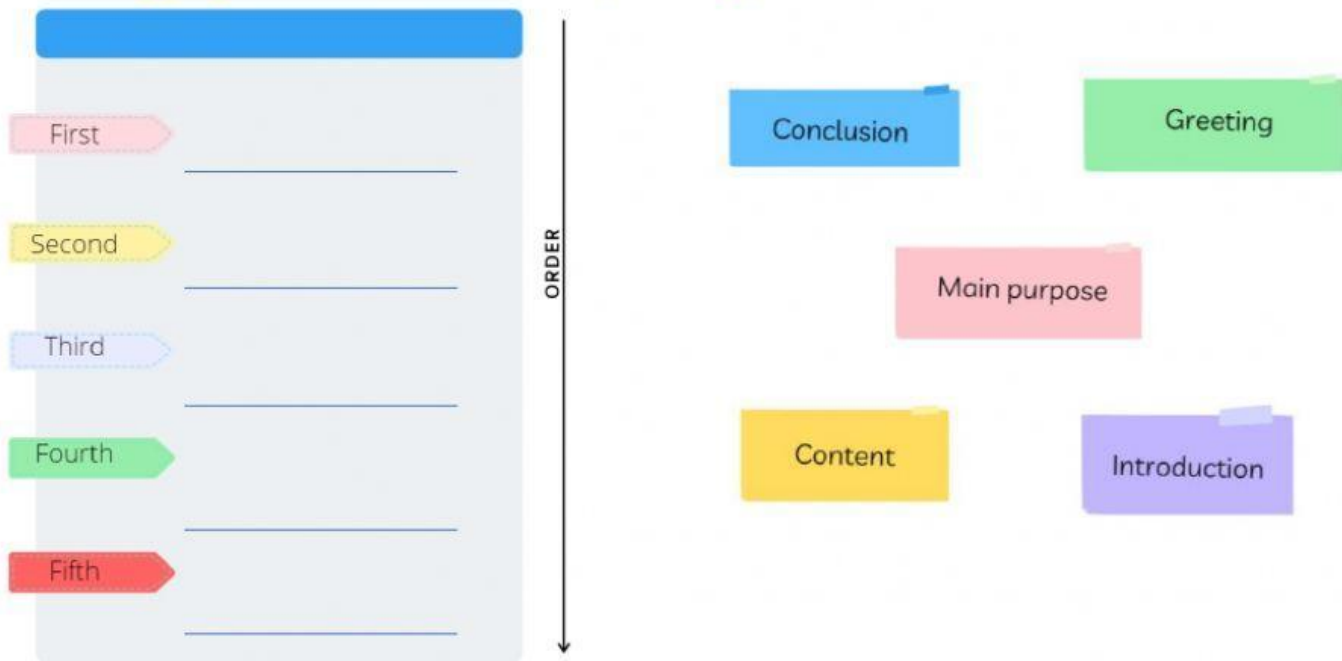
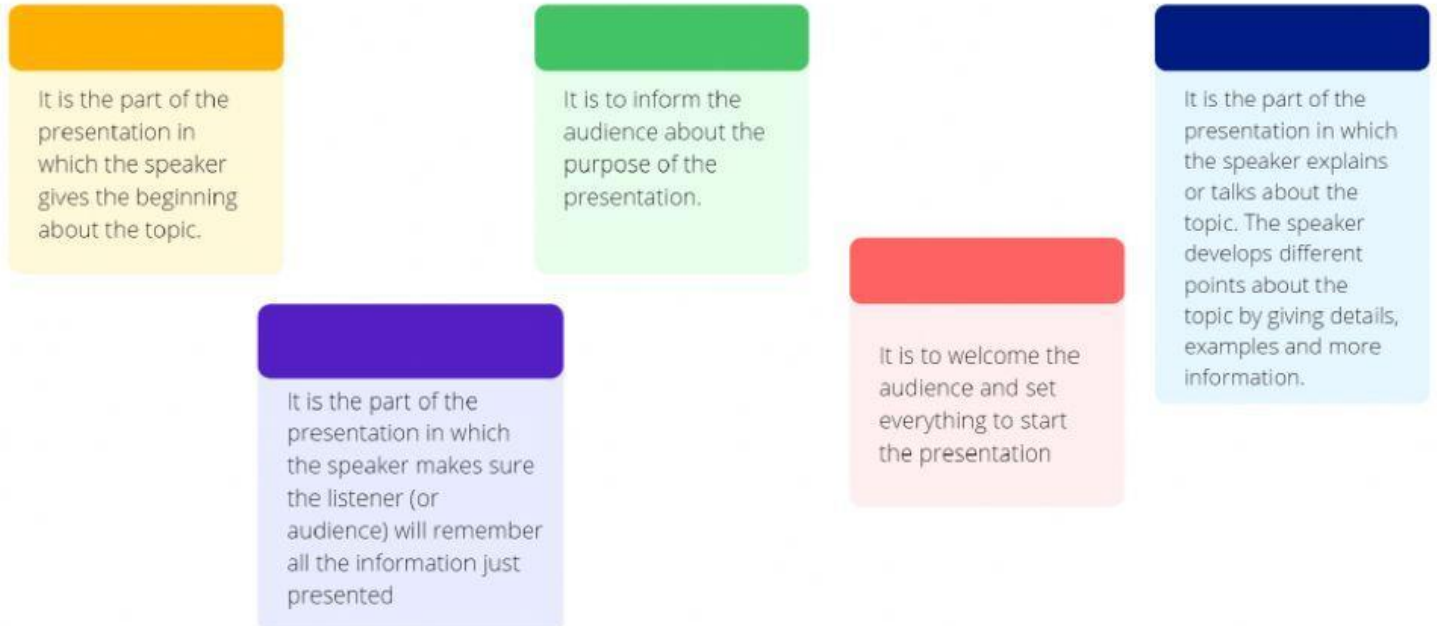


Parts of a Presentation
