Setting: The setting is where the story takes place.

Some examples of where the story can happen are: the woods, a castle, space, at the park or at the beach. Setting also includes the time or date. For example: in 2010 (past), 2040, (present), 2021 (now), in the daytime, at nighttime, in the morning, afternoon or night.

Example: In the story *Little Red Riding Hood*, the story took place at grandma's house and the woods. It happened in daytime.

I. Addition

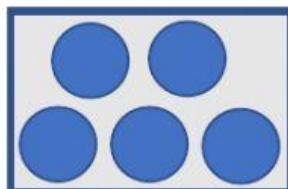
Addition is joining two groups. When adding the group gets bigger.

For example:



There are 2 circles in this box.

What will happen if we add 3 more?

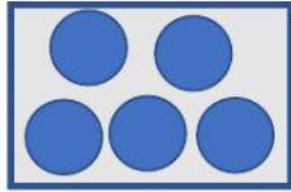


The group became bigger. Now there are 5 circles in the box.

Adding 0

When adding 0, the number that you are adding to 0 is the total.

For example: Liam placed 5 circles in the box. Tim placed none. There are still 5 circles in the box.



$$5 + 0 = 5$$
