Rounding to the Nearest Tens and Hundreds

If the digit is **0, 1, 2, 3, 4** the digit that's being rounded **stays the same** rest of the digits behind it becomes zero/s.

If the digit is **5, 6, 7, 8, 9** the digit that's being rounded, **round higher** the rest of the digits behind it becomes zero/s.
