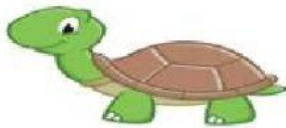


Reading Comprehension (Classification)

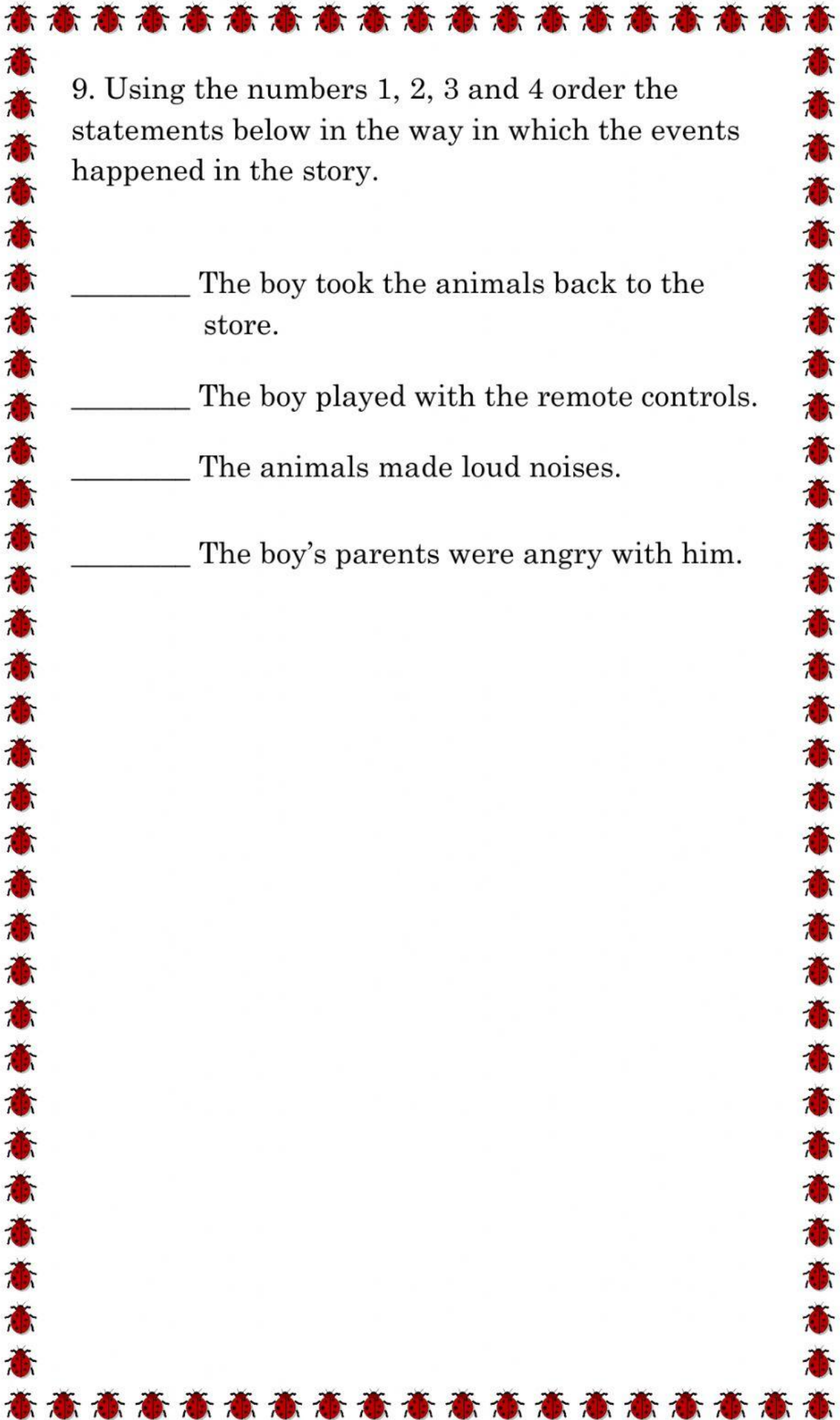
The animals all made loud sounds at the same time.
