Writing a Story

A story has a beginning, middle and end. These events together make up the PLOT.

The Beginning: introduces the characters, the setting and the problem

Characters:	Setting:
Who is your story about?	Where does it take place?

Beginning: Who? Doing what? Where? When? Problem???	Problem: what problem does he/she have?
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Middle: what action happens after the problem? What do they do to solve? First, Next, After that, Then...

Ending: How does it end? Good? Bad? What lesson do you want your readers to learn from your story?	Solution: talk about how the problem was solved
