Spelling Notes and List Words

Some singular nouns, like **moose** do not change when they become plurals. When singular nouns end in f or fe to v and add -es: calf-calves.

Some words are exceptions to this rule, such as chiefs.

Words that end in ff also form the plural by adding -s: cuff- cuffs.

When singular nouns end in o, add s to form the plural: radio-radios. Some nouns that end in o take -es to form the plural: potato-potatoes
