#### Comparatives with -er

|-------------------|-------------------|-------------|-------------------------|
| I'm               | <b>taller</b>     | <b>than</b> | you (are).              |
| You're            | <b>older</b>      |             | I am.                   |
| Maria is<br>She's | <b>shorter</b>    |             | Carlos.<br>he is / him. |
| My cat is         | <b>cuter</b>      |             | your cat.               |
| Dogs are          | <b>friendlier</b> |             | cats.                   |

Add **-er**: tall → **taller**    old → **older**    short → **shorter**  
But:    cute → **cuter**    friendly → **friendlier**
