

Combine these pairs of sentences using “too ... to” “not enough” and “so.....that”:

Examples:

The house was very expensive. We couldn't buy it.

→ The house was too expensive for us to buy it.

(lược bỏ tân ngữ “it” vì trùng với chủ ngữ “the house”)

→ The house was not cheap enough for us to buy it. (lược bỏ tân ngữ “it”)

→ The house was so expensive that we couldn't buy it.

(Notes: trong cấu trúc too ... và not ... enough, nếu tân ngữ trùng với chủ ngữ thì lược bỏ tân ngữ.)

1. That woman was very short. She could not touch the ceiling.

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2. This coat is very big. I can't wear it.

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3. The water was so hot. She couldn't drink it. (hot > < cool)

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4. That bag was very heavy. None of us could carry it.

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5. The stadium is very small. It can't hold 60,000 people.

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6. Those lessons are very difficult. He can't understand them.

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7. She was very busy. She couldn't do the housework.

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8. The climate was very bad. All the plants couldn't grow well.

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9. I'm very tired. I couldn't keep my eyes open.

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10. That boy is very lazy. He never does his homework.

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11. The bag was very heavy. She couldn't carry it.

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12. He is very old. He can't run.

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13. She is very young. She can't go to school.

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14. Tom is very short. He can't play volleyball.

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15. It's very late. We can't go to the movies.

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16. The question was very hard. We couldn't answer it.

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17. The TV program is very boring. The children don't like it.

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18. You're very young. You can't drive that car.

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19. She was tired. She didn't go anywhere.

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20. These shoes are very small. I can't wear them.

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21. He is very old. He can't wear that colourful shirt.

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22. She ran very fast. I couldn't catch her.

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23. The teacher spoke very softly. I couldn't hear her.

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24. They walked very slowly. I couldn't wait for them.

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25. This bag is very heavy. She can't carry it.

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26. The test was very difficult. The students couldn't do it.

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27. I'm very poor. I can't help you with the money.

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28. This book is very dull. We don't want to read it.

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29. The room is very dark. The children can't study in it.

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30. The dog barked too loudly. I couldn't get into sleep.

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
