Drop the y, add ~ies If words end in y then get rid of the y and add -ies baby ~ babies family ~ families story ~ stories	Drop the f, add ~ves If words end in f or fe then get rid of the f and add -ves wolf ~ wolves shelf ~ shelves knife ~ knives

Plural Nouns

A word needs to be plural when there is more than one.
Most of the time we just need to add an "s" to make a word plural.
For example: 1 dog, 2 dogs

But if the noun ends in S, X, CH or SH then we need to add "es" to make it plural.
