

Gerund-To Infinitive-Infinitive

Gerund and to infinitive verbs that can have infinitive or gerund objects, but with a difference in meaning:

Verb	Gerund	To-infinitive
1. to remember	Do it, then be aware of it	Think about it, and then do it
2. to forget	Not remember doing sth	Not remember to do sth
3. to regret	Do it, then feel bad	Feel bad, but then do it.
4. to try	Do sth as an experiment or test	Make an effort to do sth
5. to stop	To give up an action	To end an action to begin another
