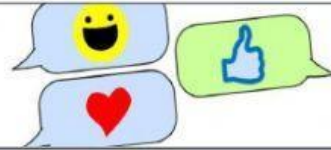
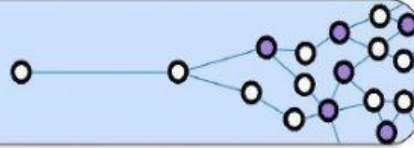


8 tips to stay safe online

1 Be nice to people online.



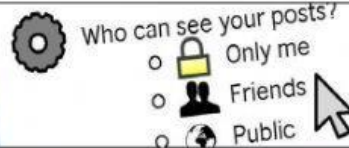
2 Take care with what you share.



3 Keep personal information private.



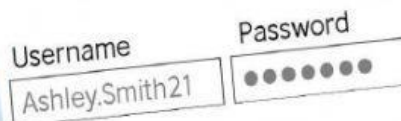
4 Check your privacy settings.

- 1) Post any personal information online – like your address, email address or mobile number.
- 2) Think carefully before posting pictures or videos of yourself. Once you've put a picture of yourself online most people can see it and may be able to download it, it's not just yours anymore.
- 3) Keep your privacy settings as high as possible
- 4) Remember that not everyone online is who they say they are
- 5) Be friendly with people you don't know
- 6) Meet up with people you've met online. Don't peak to your parent or carer about people suggesting you to do so.
- 7) Give out your passwords
- 8) Think carefully about what you say before you post something online
- 9) Respect other people's views, even if you don't agree with someone else's views doesn't mean you need to be rude
- 10) If you see something online that makes you feel uncomfortable, unsafe or worried: keep the silence, don't tell anybody, stay in the website, don't turn off your computer.
