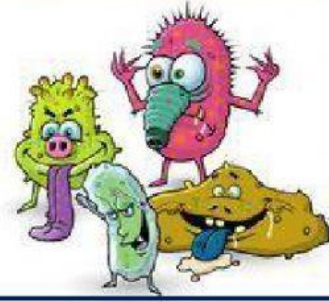

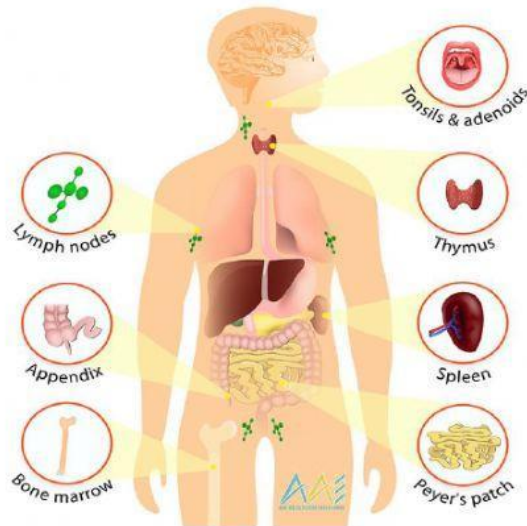

Read and answer the following questions correctly.

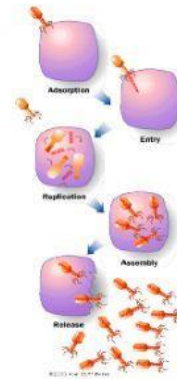
1. What is the main function of the immune system?

Using the numbers 1, 2, 3, and 4 show the steps a virus takes when it attacks the human body.

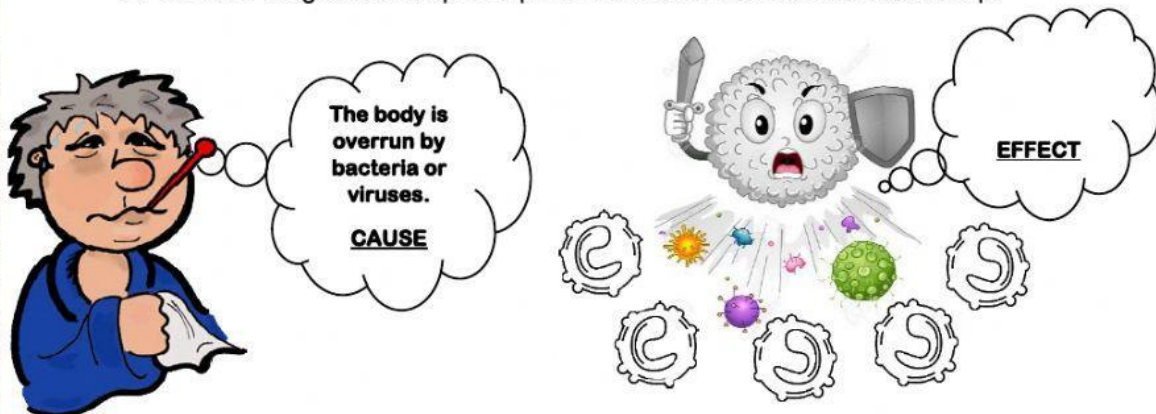
- _____ The virus duplicates in the cell.
