(B) Rules : **was / wasn't** , **were / weren't**

Examples: a. It **was** the longest competition in Olympic history. (**one** and only)

b. There **wasn't** an Olympic flag until 1920. (*not even* **one** Olympic flag)

Examples: a. Golf and rugby **were** the first events in nearly 100 years. (golf **&** rugby – **two**)

b. Women **weren't** competitors until 1900. (woman – one , women – **many**)

1. We use **there was** and **there wasn't** with (singular nouns , plural nouns).

2. We use **there were** and **there weren't** with (singular nouns , plural nouns).
