I didn't use to like fish; now I love it



- Be used to means to 'be accustomed to', or to 'be familiar with' (depends on context)

I come from a small place, but I am used to the city now

= I come from a small place, but I am familiar with the city now

= I come from a small place, but I am accustomed to the city now

His legs hurt because he wasn't used to **doing** exercise



I come from a small place, but I am used to living in the city now

= I come from a small place, but I am accustomed to living in the city now
