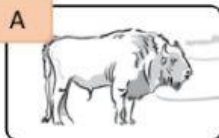

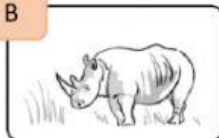

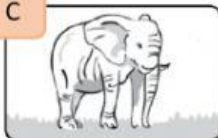

Dungeon tours take you to secret parts of the castle. You can hear amazing stories, but children must go with an adult. You need to pay extra for this tour – £2.40 for adults and £1.80 for younger people (5–16 years old). For younger children (aged 2–4) there's a new activity called 'Snapdragons'.
