

Expository Writing

A thesis statement is a statement that contains the 3 reasons/facts/events that your essay will be about.

Steps to write a thesis statement:

1. Read the topic.
2. Write three reasons, (or details) that can explain/support the topic.
3. Write the three reasons in the form of a sentence.

Example

Topic: Why should students take their education seriously?

3 reasons: determines their future
helps to combat poverty
moves the country forward

Thesis Statement: Students should take their education seriously because it determines their future, helps to combat poverty, and moves the country forward.

Topic: Do not do Drugs.

3 reasons: steal your dreams
harmful to your body
can cause your death.

Drugs can steal your dreams, are harmful to your body and ultimately can cause your death.
