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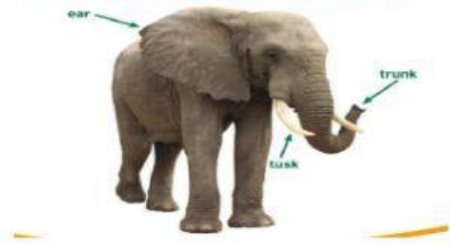

PARTS OF A BUSH ELEPHANT

**bulls**

Male elephants.

calf

A baby or young elephant.

habitats

The type of places where plants or animals normally grow or live.

herd

A group of animals that stays together.

matriarch

An older female leader.

rainforests

Areas with thick stands of tall trees and plenty of rainfall.

savanna

A grassland with few or no trees.

snorkel

A tube that sticks up above the water level, allowing a swimmer to breathe while his or her head is underwater.

sparse

Few and scattered.

tusks

Long, pointed teeth that stick out from the faces of some animals.



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
