<b>income</b>	• the money you earn from work, plus any other money you receive.
<b>wealthy</b>	• rich. SYN <b>well off</b> .
<b>worth</b>	• If a flat is <b>worth</b> €3m, you could sell it for €3m (that is the <b>value</b> ).
<b>cost a fortune</b>	• be very expensive.
<b>value sth at sth</b>	• decide what sth is worth, or what you could sell it for.
<b>waste of money</b>	• a bad use of money.
<b>own sth</b>	• If you <b>own sth</b> , it is yours; it <b>belongs to</b> you.
<b>huge</b>	• very large. SYN <b>massive</b> .
<b>amount</b>	• a quantity of sth; a sum of money.
<b>broke</b>	• INF having no money.
<b>owe sb sth</b>	• have to pay money to sb for sth they have done or given.
<b>debt</b>	• an amount of money that you owe sb.
