Landform	Description
Hill	Land that raises higher than the land around it. Its is over 300 m high.

plain	A large body of water flowing down from a mountain and empties into an ocean or sea.
mountain	A piece of land completely surrounded by waters.
Peninsula	A piece of land jutting far out into the sea and is almost surrounded by water
Island	Land that is flat or almost flat
River	The low ground between two hills or mountains
Swamp	Land that rises above the surrounding land and can reach 300 M
