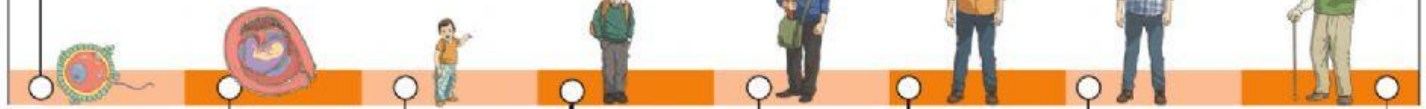


Human Life Cycle
