




5. READ AND COMPREHEND

History of Soccer

Soccer is now a global sport. It is played with a round ball. Only the player's feet and head can make contact with the ball. The ball must go into the opposing team's goal to score a point. Players run from one side of the field to the other towards the goal. There are eleven players on each team. There is a referee who sees that rules are followed.

The origins of soccer go back to China, Egypt and Rome. Balls made from animal intestines, linen or skin have been found in Egyptian tombs. Drawings show that the Egyptians rolled a ball along the ground to celebrate the richness of the land. Two thousand years later, a different game was played in China. It was called Cuju. Players stuffed feathers into a leather ball and kicked it through a goal that was made of a piece of cloth hung between two sticks. Cuju players organized matches and tournaments. Referees were used. The Chinese military played the game frequently.
