Parte entera $\times$ denominador $+$ numerador

$$2\frac{3}{4} = 2 \times 4 + 3 = \frac{11}{4}$$

$$4\frac{2}{3} = \square \times \square + \square = \frac{\square}{\square}$$

$$2\frac{3}{5} = \square \times \square + \square = \frac{\square}{\square}$$

$$4\frac{1}{2} = \square \times \square + \square = \frac{\square}{\square}$$

$$3\frac{1}{4} = \square \times \square + \square = \frac{\square}{\square}$$

$$2\frac{3}{5} = \square \times \square + \square = \frac{\square}{\square}$$
