



Would like...

We use "WOULD LIKE" to make a polite request. .For example, we use it to make sentences and ask for a gift in a Christmas letter: **SUBJECT (I) + VERB (would like) + COMPLEMENT (a bike for Christmas).**

Usamos "WOULD LIKE" para hacer una petición formal. Por ejemplo, lo usamos para armar oraciones y pedir un regalo en una carta de navidad: **SUJETO (yo) + VERBO (quisiera) + COMPLEMENTO (una bicicleta en Navidad).**
