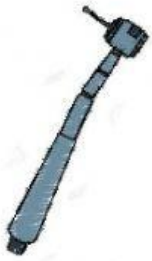

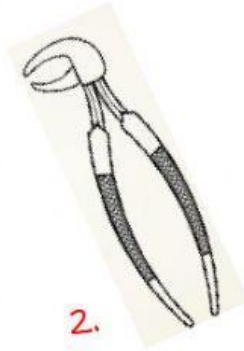

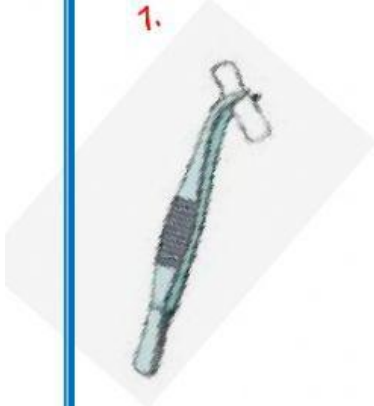

1. _____ Commonly, a scissor-action, pointed-jawed tool for bending or cutting metal wires or grasping small objects.
2. _____ An instrument commonly used for viewing occlusal and distal surfaces of teeth.
3. _____ An instrument utilized in the removal of damaged tissue from a wound of pulp chambers (cavities) and channels of the teeth.
4. _____ An instrument for holding dental burs to remove tooth structure or to smooth and polish restorative materials. Rotations are measured in rotations per second
5. _____ Used by dentists for the injection of an anesthetic.
6. _____ Aid in placing small objects inside the mouth and in retrieving small objects from the mouth.
7. _____ Usually containing fluoride, is used with the rubber cups for polishing.
