

PAST CONTINUOUS

1. Form: S + was/ were + V-ing

Affirmative		
I / he / she / it	was	walking
you / we / they	were	
Negative		
I / he / she / it	was not (wasn't)	walking
you / we / they	were not (weren't)	
Question		
Was	I / he / she / it	walking?
Were	you / we / they	

2. Use

- We use Past Continuous to talk about an action happening at a particular time in the past.

Ex: What **were you doing** at one o' clock? I **was having** lunch.

- We use Past Continuous and "while" to talk about two or more actions which were happening at the same time in the past.

Ex: While Mom **was cooking**, I **was cleaning** the floor.

- We use Past Continuous and "when" (or sometimes "while") to talk about an action interrupted another action in the past. We use "Past Continuous" for the longer action happening at that time and use "Past Simple" for action with shorter duration and the interrupted action.

Ex: We **were talking** when the teacher **came**.

Peter and Tim **came** while we **were watching** TV.

- 3. **Time expressions:** while, when, all day, all night, all morning, at ... o' clock yesterday.
