Princess Diana was born 1<sup>st</sup> July 1961 at 7:45 PM weighing 7lb 12oz at Park House, Sandringham, Norfolk, England, UK.

Her full name is Lady Diana Frances Spencer. She was the daughter of Edward John Spencer and Frances Ruth Burke Roche.

On 29<sup>th</sup> July 1981 she married her Prince Charming - Prince Charles of Wales, the eldest son of Queen Elizabeth II. On 21<sup>st</sup> June 1982 her first son was born - Prince William Arthur Phillip Louis Windsor. Two years later, on 15<sup>th</sup> September 1984, Diana's second and youngest son was born - Prince Henry Charles Albert David Windsor.

On 28<sup>th</sup> August 1996, the "Fairy-Tale" marriage was over, Princess Diana and her husband had a divorce. A year later on 30<sup>th</sup> August 1997, the beloved Princess died in a car accident.

During her final year, she highly supported the International Campaign to Ban Landmines, a campaign which won the Nobel Peace Prize in 1997, only a few months after her death. Diana today is still remembered by many as the "people's princess". She will always be remembered.
