

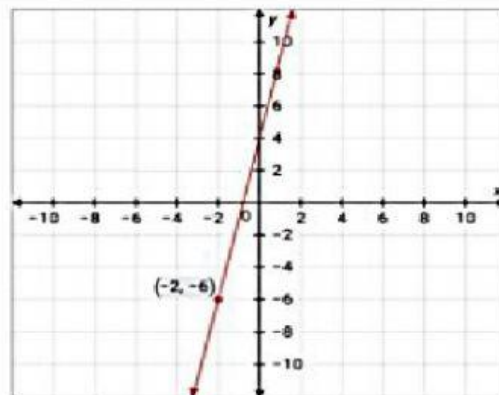
A line passes through points $(-3, -1)$ and $(2, 14)$.

$$-y = 4(x + 6)$$
