

Comparatives and Superlatives

We use comparatives to compare two objects or people

Groot is **smaller** than spiderman.
Spiderman is **taller** than Groot.



- We add **-er** to short adjectives: small (smaller) – tall (taller) – big (bigger) – Thin (thinner) – old (older)
- Doctor Strange is **more** adventurous than Hulk.
- Hulk is **more** dangerous than Doctor Strange.
- We add the word **more** to long adjectives:
(More beautiful) – **(More courageous)**

We use superlatives to differentiate one object or person from the rest.

Groot is **the shortest** avenger.
Hulk is **the biggest**.



- We add “**the +est**” to short adjectives: small (**smallest**) – tall (**tallest**) – big (**biggest**) – Thin (**thinnest**) – old (**oldest**)
- Dr strange is **the most** intelligent.
Hulk is **the most** dangerous.
- We add “**the most**” to long adjectives: dangerous (**the most dangerous**) – beautiful (**the most beautiful**) – courageous (**the most courageous**)
