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| <p><b>a</b> "Uh, the sensible thing to do would be to <b>save</b> <u>it for a rainy / windy day</u> or <b>pay off</b> my <u>debt / debit</u>, but I think I'd rather <b>splash</b> <u>out / across</u> on a family vacation."</p> | <p><b>b</b> "Well, I certainly wouldn't save or invest it - I'd probably <b>throw / blow it</b> on a new music system and some massive speakers."</p> | <p><b>c</b> "I think I'd be tempted to get a new computer. Mine's getting a little slow. You can <b>get</b> <u>them for peanuts / doughnuts</u> these days, you know ..."</p> |
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
