EXAMPLES:

Affirmative: You **are** on the left side of the plane

Negative: You **aren't** on the left side of the plane

Interrogative: **Are** you on the left side of the plane?

Affirmative: The seat number **is** A42.

Negative: It **isn't** A42.

Interrogative: **Is** it A42?
