

**READ and MATCH.**

Vowel	●	the way in which a syllable in a word is given more force.
Word Family	●	a group of words that have the same basic form.
Weak form	●	a unit of sound within a word.
Suffix	●	is an affix placed before the stem of a word.
Prefix	●	a sound that involves two vowels joined together.
Consonant	●	a letter or group of letters that can be added to the end of a word to change its meaning.
Word Stress	●	A speech sound made by blocking or partly blocking the air used to make the sound.
Syllable	●	a speech sound made without blocking the air used to produce the sound.
Diphthong	●	when a word changes its pronunciation according to whether it is stressed or not. (It is the unstressed version)
