→ Some people think that **it is necessary for** young people **to** be ambitious. _____

2. Nối 2 hoặc nhiều câu trong đề bài:

Khi 2 câu riêng lẻ cùng nói về 1 ý kiến, thường 2 câu sẽ có quan hệ với nhau về mặt ý nghĩa (nguyên nhân – kết quả, đối lập, ví dụ). Khi đó, dù vẫn giữ 2 câu hoặc gộp thành 1 câu có 2 vế, ta nên nối chúng bằng từ nối phù hợp khi paraphrase đề bài.

Example 1:

Disruptive school students have a negative influence on others. (1) Students who are noisy and disobedient should be grouped together and taught separately. (2) To what extent do you agree or disagree?

→ It is true that disruptive students may negatively affect their peers' academic performance. Therefore, those who do not obey school rules and regulations ought to be taught in separate groups.

3. Đối với những câu nêu lên ý kiến ta có thể thêm **cum nêu ý kiến**. Đối với dạng đề bài nêu lên sự thật ta có thể thêm **cum nêu lên sự thật**.

Common synonyms

1. **Cum nêu ý kiến**: Some/Many people think that + clause

= Some/Many people hold the view that + clause

= **It is** a widespread/common belief that + clause

= **It is** believed that + clause

Cum nêu lên sự thật:

It is true/evident that + clause

= It is a fact that + clause

2. should = ought to

3. young people = the youth = the young = youngsters = young(er) generations

4. old people = the elderly = the old = elders = old(er) generations

5. teenagers = adolescents

6. more and more + adj = increasingly + adj

more and more + noun = an increasing number/amount of + noun

7. people = individuals

8. increase = be on the increase

increase at an alarming rate

decrease = be on the decrease

9. today = nowadays = in today's world

10. negatively/adversely/detrimentally affect/impact/influence + s.o/sth

= **have a** negative/adverse/detrimental effect/impact/influence + **ON** + s.o/sth
