She wears a uniform
He helps people
She drives a taxi

NEGATIVE (Super DOESN'T)

He doesn't work in a shop
She doesn't wear a uniform
He doesn't help people
She doesn't drive a taxi

QUESTIONS (Super DOES)

Does he work in a shop?
Does she wear a uniform?
Does he help people?
Does she drive a taxi?
